## 2023 City of Naples Utility Rates

Effective October 1, 2022- Water, Reclaimed, Sewer \& Garbage Rates increased by 5\%, Stormwater Rates increased by 9.6\%.

## Bimonthly Water Base Charge

All City of Naples utility customers are charged a bimonthly base charge, even if no water is used. The rate is based on the chart to the right.

In addition to the bimonthly base charge, all single family residential and commercial customers will be charged the following consumption rates according to their actual installed meter size, while Multi-family residences will be charges following consumption rates based upon the number of dwelling units. Customers with 1 -inch meters who use from zero to 38,000 gallons are in Block 1. If their water usage increases from 38,001 to 75,000 , then they move to Block 2. It is therefore most beneficial to use lowered amounts of water because the higher blocks are charged at higher rates.

## Stormwater Charges

Stormwater charges are established in the City Code Appendix A.

Utility bills are distributed to customers every two months. Customers outside the city limits are subject to a 25 percent surcharge.

Bimonthly Sewer Service Charge
Residential, non-residential and Multi-family Residential residents are charged a bimonthly base charge. In addition, each customer is charged a consumption fee, based on the number of gallons of water used. Each single-family dwelling has a 20,000-gallon bimonthly cap. The cap does not apply if an irrigation meter, sub-meter, or reclaimed water meter serves the property.

## Reclaimed (Irrigation) Water Charges

Reclaimed (irrigation) water has limited availability. The base bimonthly charge is based on the water meter size. In addition, the customer is charges a consumption fee based on the type of agreement they have with the City. If reclaimed water is available in the area, a base fee of $\$ 20.02$ bimonthly will be charged for availability whether the meter is connected or not. See the chart to the right for specifics.

## Fees

The fee to test a water meter is $\$ 68$ for meters $5 / 8$ inch to $1^{\prime \prime}$. The rate of testing meters $11 / 2$ inches and larger varies. Contact the Utilities Department at 213-4745 for additional information.

## Late Fees

There is a 5 percent penalty assessed to utility accounts

## Reinstatement of Water Service

When service has been cut off or discontinued for nonpayment of current bills, service will be reinstated upon prompt payment of unpaid bills, plus a service fee of $\$ 26$. When reinstatement is performed outside of normal working hours, per customer request, the fee is $\$ 85$. Normal working hours are 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.

## Reinstatement of Water Service after Meter is Locked

If water service has been discontinued for more than 5 days, by request or otherwise, the service line gate or curb stop valve will be locked in the off position. Reinstatement or unlocking of the meter is $\$ 75$. If this is performed outside of normal working hours, per customer request, the fee is $\$ 135$. Normal working hours are 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.

## Dishonored Checks

Per occurrence, the rate is based on the amount of the check.

## Hydrant Service

There is a $\$ 1$ per day fee after 90 days.
