



Fire Hydrant Flow Test Submittal Guide for Applicants

PURPOSE

This guide provides a step by step aid for submitting a request for a Fire Hydrant Flow Test.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- ✓ Required documents for this application include a Fire Hydrant Flow Test Application Form and an aerial showing the location of the hydrant.
- ✓ For multiple hydrants a spereate request is required for each hydrant.

PROCEDURE

1. Sign in by clicking the Sign in Link.
2. Under the Building Department Icon click Apply for a Building Permit.





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3. Choose the application type by selecting **Fire**.
4. Categorize the nature of the work being done by selecting the appropriate item.
5. In the description of work type **Flow Test**.
6. Enter the Building Use.
7. Complete all remaining required information marked with an asterick*.

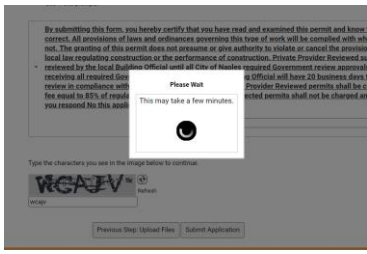


