ORDER # 6

TERMINATING CURFEW (Order #2)
ON NOVEMBER 10, 2022 AT 10:00 PM

WHEREAS, on October 3, 2022, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Naples, Florida, pursuant to Section 14-38, of the Code of the City of Naples, the Declarations of Local Emergency, dated September 27, 2022, and Resolution 2022-14951 dated September 30, 2022, I issued State of Emergency – Hurricane Ian Order #2, which declared a curfew in residential areas from 10:00 PM until 6:00 AM beginning on 10/3/2022 until rescinded; and

WHEREAS, as the City continues to recover from the effects of Hurricane Ian, the need for continuation of the curfew was reviewed by the City Manager and the City’s emergency management staff, who have advised me that it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to consider termination of the curfew, which is in effect.

NOW THEREFORE, I HEREBY DECLARE:

Section 1. State of Emergency –Hurricane Ian Order 2, which imposed a curfew in the residential areas of the City of Naples is terminated as of November 10 at 10:00 PM.
