Our services are designed to promote a healthy and active lifestyle while providing opportunities for recreation, leisure, socialization, independence, integration, education, and an overall improved quality of life.

We welcome people of all abilities to participate in our programs! We also collaborate with other organizations that specialize in adaptive recreation services to offer a variety of program choices.

The City of Naples is here to enhance, educate and empower individuals with disabilities and special needs through leisure and recreation activities, providing life changing opportunities to sustain a better quality of life.

Reasonable Accommodations

In order for individuals with disabilities to participate as fully as possible, reasonable accommodations are provided in accordance with Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Reasonable accommodations are defined as individualized techniques and resources used to enhance program participation without fundamentally altering a program. This requires that participants register for age-appropriate activities and for programs based on abilities.

Program Participation

Special Needs/ Inclusion programs are being offered throughout the year for individuals with various disabilities. Programs such as summer camp, holiday break camps, and schools out fun days are for school-age participants.

Policies and Forms

It is the goal of our program to provide a positive, safe, and fun recreation experience for all individuals. We ask that parents/caregivers meet with staff in order to complete a Participant Information Form. If there are any changes within the year, parents/caregiver are responsible to update this information as soon as possible. This information will be used by staff to ensure that each participant receives the best experience possible.

Personal Care Assistance

The City of Naples Parks, Recreation and Facilities Department provides recreation services for the community. The City of Naples Parks, Recreation and Facilities Department does not provide personal care services. Participants requiring personal care are required to have their own personal care assistant to assist with each their personal care services. Personal care services include toileting, feeding and dressing. The minimum age for a personal care assistant is 18 years of age. A background screening will be required.
