The Master Plan was created to ensure that the current legacy of parks and open spaces will be secured for future generations. The department has been hard at work to make this happen. Staff have been busy developing and implementing plans that were reviewed and approved by the public and city council. We first concentrated on Anthony Park. Open access restrooms were constructed, a kayak launch was put in, an outdoor fitness area has been installed, additional park lighting added, a large gazebo added and lastly staff will work on the new entrance design and improvements to the open field. Next on the list we will be focusing on improvements at Fleischmann Park. The first project the park will undergo is to replace the heavily used playground with a ADA compliant playground that will include a themed playground with slides, swings, accessibility components, turf and a gazebo. We are all excited to see all the improvements being made to our wonderful parks!

Infants 6 months to 3 years:

The purpose of parent and child aquatics is to teach safe behaviors around the water and develop swimming readiness by leading parents and their children in water exploration activities with the objective of having fun and becoming comfortable in, or around water.

Preschool Aquatics

(Level 1: 4-year-olds:

Level 2: 5-year-olds):

Preschool aquatics aims to promote the developmentally appropriate learning of fundamental water safety and aquatic skills by young children. Red Cross preschool aquatics teaches aquatic and safety skill sin a logical progression through 3 levels of courses.

Learn to Swim (recommended minimum age is 6 years old):

Rec Cross Learn-to-Swim consists of 6 comprehensive levels that teach people of varying ages and abilities how to swim skillfully and safely. Each level includes training in basic water safety. All aquatic and safety skills are taught in a logical progression. The objective is to teach people to swim and to be safe in, on and around water. Level 1 – Introduction to Water Skills; Level 2 – Fundamental Aquatic Skills; Level 3 & 4 – Stroke Development/Improvement.

Adult Swim (minimum age is approximately 13):

This course is intended for teens and adults at different levels of swimming abilities. This course can help teens or adults overcome their fear of the water and to learn the basic skills to achieve a minimum level of water competency.

Private Lessons:

Would you prefer a one-on-one lesson for yourself or your child, or a semi-private class for two participants? Anyone with a fear of the water, a specific stroke to improve or a desire for individual attention can benefit from private lessons. Moreover, if you're familiar with a variety of strokes you may like a stroke clinic to improve your efficiency, endurance or prepare for an open water swim.

The emphasis will be on cardio-respiratory endurance, core & muscle strength, improving balance & posture, toning up and burning fat. Classes can be held in shallow water or deep water. Most of the class is in an upright, standing position in shallow water. Flotation aids will be utilized in shallow water for those concerned about placing stress on joints, and in deep water for those who are not expert swimmers. Beach Parking Permits

Beach parking permits allow for free parking at all Collier County and City Beaches. Permits are free to all tax paying residents of Collier County. Full time residents are required to bring a Florida drivers license with Collier County address along with their Collier County vehicle registration. Part-time residents must bring their out of state drivers license and vehicle registration plus one of the following: Collier County tax statement, Collier County tax receipt, Closing papers for property in Collier County (if purchased within 90 days). No photocopies are accepted and all documents must have the same name and address. Apply permit to bottom left side of windshield.

BEACH PARKING WITH A HANDICAP STICKER

Any disability permit holder may park at any space without payment, in accordance with Florida Statute 316.1964. The only requirement is that the permit holder is driving or being transported. A disability permit does NOT allow parking in a bus loading zone, fire zone, handicapped access aisles, any areas posted as no parking zones, or parking in excess of the posted time limit. Also, no parking is allowed at any metered beach parking space between 11 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Dog Park

Naples Dog Park



The Naples Dog Park is located on the northeast corner of Goodlette-Frank Road and Central Avenue and includes two separate off-the-leash areas. The South section, composed of approximately 1 acre of fenced area is for large dogs while the North section composed of .35 acres is dedicated to small dogs. Located centrally in the park is a shade structure that includes benches, drinking fountains for humans and dogs, as well as a picnic area. There are approximately 43 parking spaces to the North, a sidewalk connection to the greenway and place for public art. The fencing is adorned with lush landscaping. PETS IN THE PARKS...

Please help to keep our parks safe for people and pets by keeping your dogs on a leash. Dogs in Park Ordinance Approved by City Council on September 26, 2006 ORDINANCE CHAPTER 28, SECTION 35, SUBSECTION C: It shall be unlawful for the owner of an animal to allow such animal to enter or be within any public park of the City, unless designated otherwise, providing that the animal must be on a leashed restraint and under owner control at all times, that the owner must remove and properly dispose of all animal waste and that the owner is responsible for all actions of the animal. Animals are not allowed in any city athletic fields, the Naples Preserve, city beach or city playground.

Any person violating this section shall be guilty of an infraction, which shall be punishable by a fine of not less than fifty dollars per violation with each day or partial day of violation counting as a separate offense.

- ✓ Pets must be leashed and under owner control
- ✓ Pet waste must be removed and disposed of properly
- ✓ Pets are not allowed in City playgrounds or athletic surfaces
- ✓ Pets are not allowed on any City beach
- ✓ Pets are not allowed at the Naples Preserve
