Aquatics

The River Park Aquatic Center features year-round FREE general admission. Our six-lap lanes (25 yards) pool connects to a separate teaching and catch pool where the 9.9-foot-high, 360-degree water slide empties into, and leads to a zero-depth beach entry pool with interactive water feature. The pool is heated or chilled depending on the weather. The water temperatures are maintained between 78-82 degrees. The bath house offers a clean family restroom, and men's and women's restrooms which include showers for your convenience. Lockers are available to rent during your stay. A large, shaded pavilion with ceiling fans and vending machines allows you to enjoy snacks or a meal you brought with you. The River Park Aquatic Center will not open in the event the forecast high for the day is not expected to reach 60 degrees. Parent and Child Acquatics Infants 6 months to 3 years:

The purpose of parent and child aquatics is to teach safe behaviors around the water and develop swimming readiness by leading parents and their children in water exploration activities with the objective of having fun and becoming comfortable in, or and around water.

Preschool Aquatics Level 1: 4-year-olds Level 2: 5-year-olds

Preschool aquatics aims to promote the developmentally appropriate learning of fundamental water safety and aquatic skills by young children. Red Cross preschool aquatics teaches aquatic and safety skills in a logical progression through 3 levels of courses.

Learn to Swim (recommended minimum age is 6 years old):

Rec Cross Learn-to-Swim consists of 6 comprehensive levels that teach people of varying ages and abilities how to swim skillfully and safely. Each level includes training in basic water safety. All aquatic and safety skills are taught in a logical progression. The objective is to teach people to swim and to be safe in, on and around water. Level 1: Introduction to Water

Skills Level 2: Fundamental Aquatic Skills Level 3 & 4: Stroke Development/

Improvement

Adult Swim Learning the Basics (minimum age is approximately 13):

This course is intended for teens and adults at different levels of swimming abilities. This course can help teens or adults overcome their fear of the water and to learn the basic skills to achieve a minimum level of water competency.

Multi-Level Aqua Exercise (Adults)

Enjoy the benefits of getting a total body workout utilizing the lowimpact properties of an aquatic environment. The emphasis will be on cardio-respiratory endurance, core & muscle strength, improving balance & posture, toning up and burning fat. Classes can be held in shallow water or deep water. Most of the class is in an upright. standing position in shallow water. Flotation aids will be utilized in shallow water for those concerned about placing stress on joints, and in deep water for those who are not expert swimmers. Exercises are designed so everyone can work to their ability and improve Activities of Daily Living.

Beach Parking Permits

Beach parking permits allow for free parking at all Collier County and City Beaches. Permits are free to all tax paying residents of Collier County. Full time residents are required to bring a Florida drivers license with Collier County address along with their Collier County vehicle registration. Part-time residents must bring their out of state drivers license and vehicle registration plus one of the following: Collier County tax statement, Collier County tax receipt, Closing papers for property in Collier County (if purchased within 90 days). No photocopies are accepted and all documents must have the same name and address. Apply permit to bottom left side of windshield.

City of Naples residents may acquire their beach parking permits at City Hall from 8:00 am – 5:00 pm, Monday thru Friday. Collier County residents may acquire their pass from the following Collier County Parks and Recreation locations:

BEACH PARKING WITH A HANDICAP STICKER

Any disability permit holder may park at any space without payment, in accordance with Florida Statute 316.1964. The only requirement is that the permit holder is driving or being transported. A disability permit does NOT allow parking in a bus loading zone, fire zone, handicapped access aisles, any areas posted as no parking zones, or parking in excess of the posted time limit. Also, no parking is allowed at any metered beach parking space between 11 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Dog Park

Naples Dog Park



The Naples Dog Park is located on the northeast corner of Goodlette-Frank Road and Central Avenue and includes two separate off-the-leash areas. The South section, composed of approximately 1 acre of fenced area is for large dogs while the North section composed of .35 acres is dedicated to small dogs. Located centrally in the park is a shade structure that includes benches, drinking fountains for humans and dogs, as well as a picnic area. There are approximately 43 parking spaces to the North, a sidewalk connection to the greenway and place for public art. The fencing is adorned with lush landscaping. The off-the-leash areas are a combination of dog friendly mulch and a nice grassy circumference for running.

Please help to keep our parks safe for people and pets by keeping your dogs on a leash. Dogs in Park Ordinance Approved by City Council on September 26, 2006 ORDINANCE CHAPTER 28, SECTION 35, SUBSECTION C: It shall be unlawful for the owner of an animal to allow such animal to enter or be within any public park of the City, unless designated otherwise, providing that the animal must be on a leashed restraint and under owner control at all times, that the owner must remove and properly dispose of all animal waste and that the owner is responsible for all actions of the animal. Animals are not allowed in any city athletic fields, the Naples Preserve, city beach or city playground.

Any person violating this section shall be guilty of an infraction, which shall be punishable by a fine of not less than fifty dollars per violation with each day or partial day of violation counting as a separate offense.

- ✔ Pets are not allowed in City playgrounds or athletic surfaces
- ✔ Pets are not allowed on any City beach
