

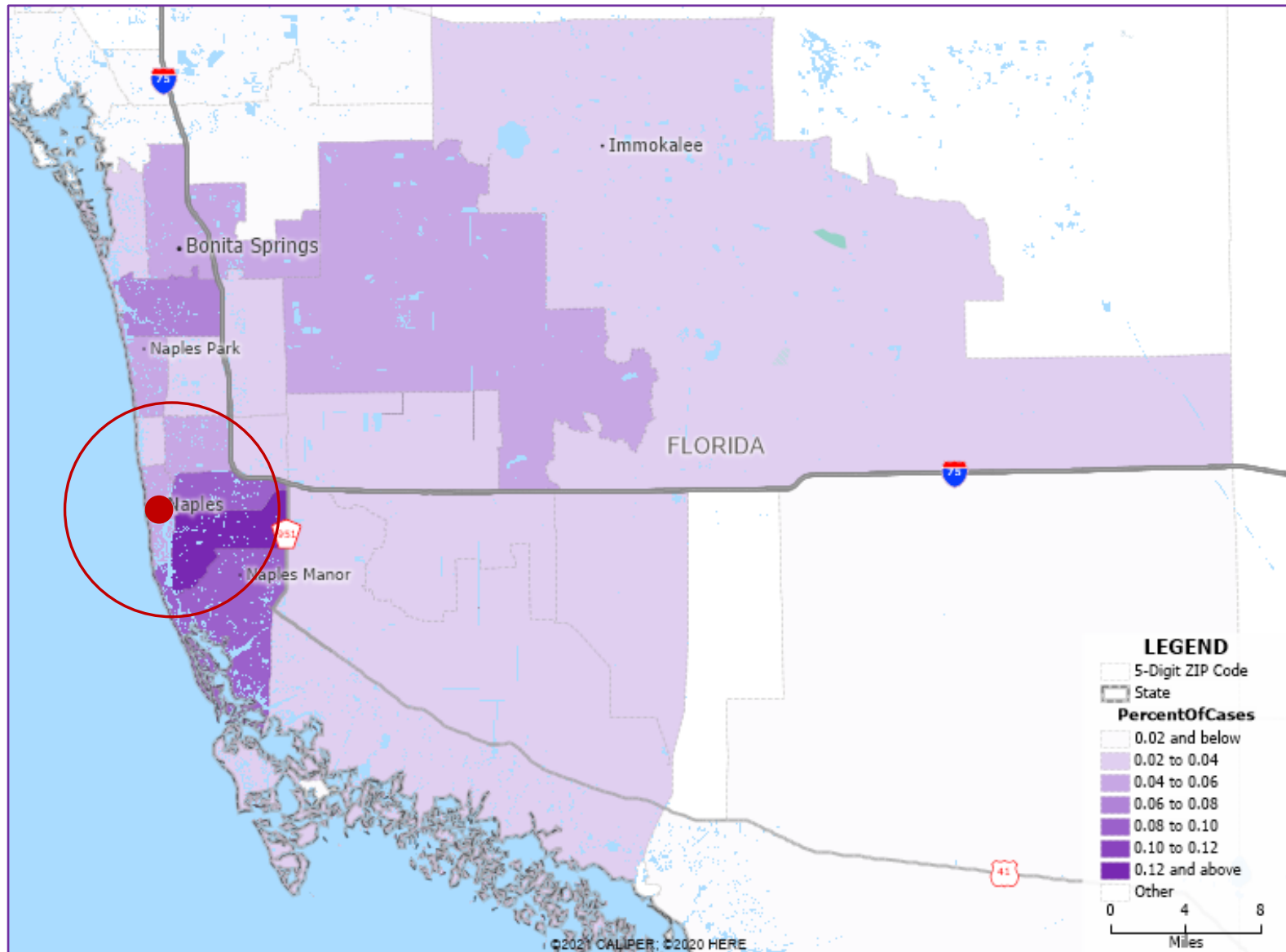

# NCH Baker Hospital Emergency Stroke Patients



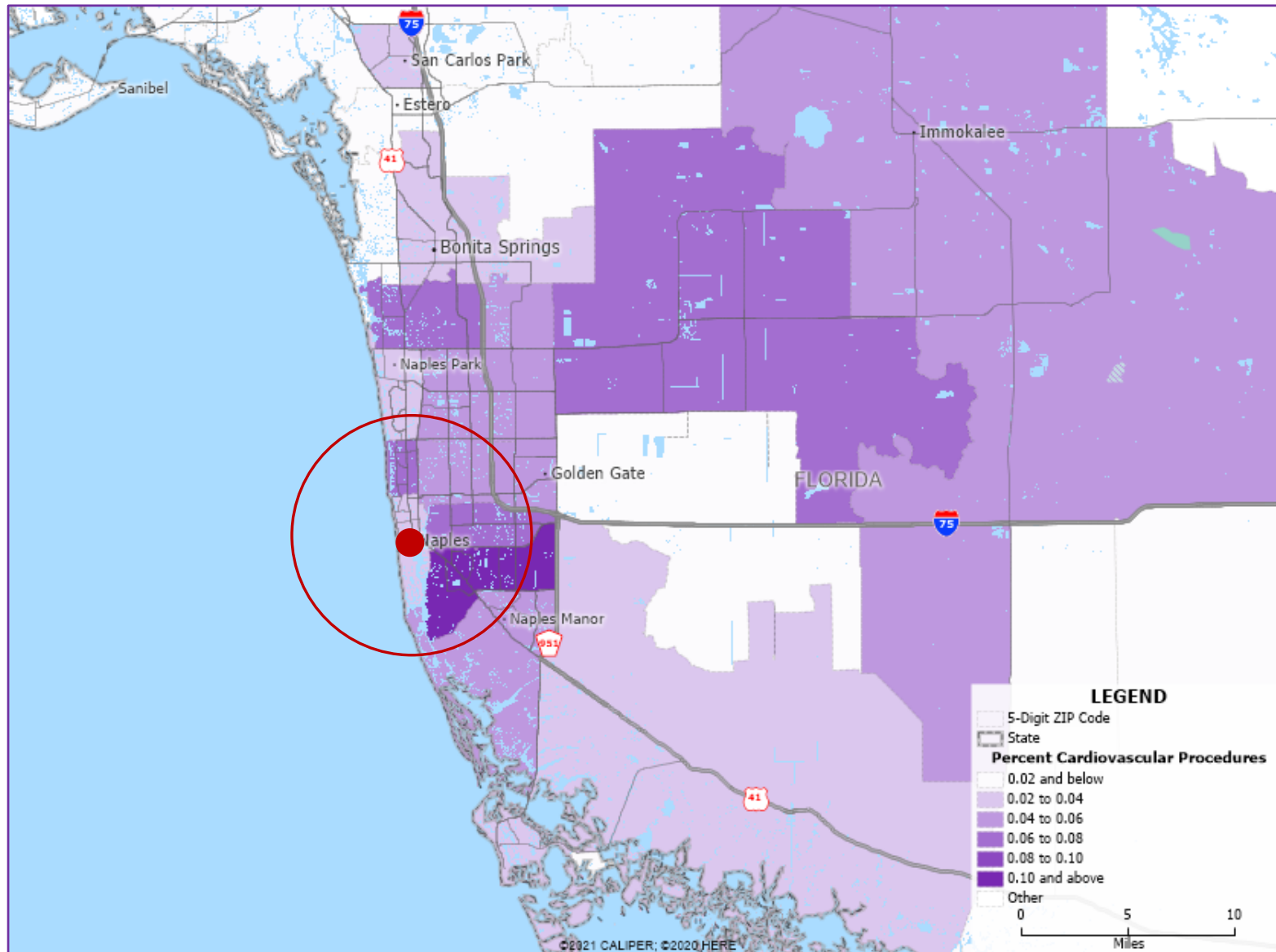
- 53% within 5-miles of hospital
