## The following answers to written submitted questions:

My only question is what is the required shell content of the reef compared to limestone?

ANSWER: Oversized, large washed shell/limestone rock (minimum size  $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " i.e. does NOT pass through a  $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " screen) that comes from the same mine location i.e. mostly large shell, but coral/limestone mixed in is acceptable. Also, be advised as stated in the RFP, the City must approve all materials prior to purchase and construction.
