2. Form "City of Naples Release and Affidavit Form" on pg. 39 is listed as one of the required forms for the bid submittal, however this is a form related to actual contract and pay requests, not bid submittal. Can you please confirm if this form needs to be submitted with our bid?

ANSWER: Pursuant to page 40 Index, this not REQUIRED on submittal, however the form is REQUIRED upon Final Payment or Retainage.

- 3. Page 41, Project Requirements and Specifications, A. states "The contractor will be responsible for dewatering the material according to environmental permitting conditions and disposing of it at an approved location".
 - Can you provide the environmental permit so we can review these requirements?
