Some sharps users throw their used needles in the trash or flush them down the toilet. Used sharps left loose among waste can cause unexpected injuries. Children, adults, even pets are at risk for needle stick injuries when sharps are disposed of improperly at home or public settings. People exposed to sharps face the risk of contracting a life altering disease such as HIV/AIDS or Hepatitis B or C. Needle stick injuries are a PREVENTABLE health risk.
