- Suggested Species for Shoreline Areas:**
- Muhly grass
 - Dwarf Fakahatchee grass
 - Golden creeper (groundcover)
 - Beach sunflower 'Dune supreme' (groundcover)
 - Marshhay cordgrass and sand cordgrass
 - Golden leather fern
- Additional Suggestions:**
- Lemon bacopa as groundcover on steep slopes where invasive species removed
 - Dahoon holly to replace Brazilian pepper with similar screening plant

- Suggested Species for Littoral Shelves (depth zone):**
- A Fragrant waterlily (A)
 - B Bulrush (B)
 - C Spikerush (B)
 - C Duck potato and broadleaf arrowhead (C)
 - C Swamp lily (C)
 - D Cinnamon fern (D) (shade)
 - D Swamp rosemallow (D)
