



City of Naples Lakes Improvement Project

Naples, FL (July 20, 2020) – The City of Naples is seeking public input from our residents for the design plan options being proposed to improve and enhance the water quality, functionality, and aesthetics of three lakes within the City of Naples. The three lakes are 15th Ave N. Lake (Lake 19) which is located just south of Fleischmann Park baseball fields, Spring Lake (Lake 11) and East Lake (31) which are located just south of 5th Avenue South between West Lake Drive and East Lake Drive and north of 8th Avenue South. All three lakes are being proposed to be dredged removing accumulated sediment and pollutants as well as restoring historical depths. A variety of other improvements are also being considered including aerators with floc logs, floating islands, creation of littoral shelves, removal of exotics, a sidewalk extension (Lake 19), nutrient separating baffle boxes, and a wetland treatment area (East Lake).

We encourage those that have interest in these projects to visit NaplesLakesImprovement.com to find out more detailed information and for the opportunity to provide comments from the website. Public input is very important in the design of the lake restoration projects. The design will be developed based on input by the City Council as well as the surrounding community to ensure the plan serves the goals and intent of the community.

The comment period is from July 20th - August 2, 2020.
