








BIG PICTURE


- CITY OWNS APPROXIMATELY 3,280 FT OF CONCRETE SEAWALL ALONG GULF SHORE BOULEVARD NORTH (GSBN)
- SEAWALLS PROTECT THE SHORELINE AT SIX OUTLOTS [A, B, C, D, E AND F] ADJACENT TO THE GSBN ROW
- EXCEPT FOR 750 FT ALONG SEAGATE DRIVE, 100 PERCENT OF THE SHORELINE WITHIN VENETIAN BAY AND INNER DOCTORS BAY IS HARDENED BY VERTICAL SEAWALLS












VENETIAN BAY


VICINITY MAP



THE ISSUE

- ► FAILED 150 FT SECTION OF SEAWALL AT OUTLET "E" ➢OVER 40 YEARS OLD ▶2015 – INITIAL WALL **MOVEMENT, IMPROPER EMBEDMENT OF TIE RODS INTO CONCRETE CAP BEAM** >2017 - HEAVY RAINS AND EXTREME LOW WATER
 - EXTREME LOW WATER CAUSED BY HURRICANE IRMA RESULTED IN SIGNIFICANT ROTATION OF TOP OF WALL
