March 21st, 2023 PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

The City of Naples is currently looking for resident feedback regarding the intersection of 9th Street South and 10th Avenue South. The Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT's) standard for signalized intersections within 10-miles of the coastline is a mast arm assembly to provide greater resiliency and a higher level of public safety during high wind events associated with intense storms and hurricanes. The existing span wire system at the intersection does not meet this standard.

The City is proposing to convert the span wire traffic signal system to a hurricane resistant mast-arm assembly. Also, the City intended to address the increasing concerns from property owners along 10th Avenue South regarding high vehicle speeds and truck volumes. The proposed project will integrate traffic calming components in the form of raised and decorative median islands at the intersection and slightly narrower travel lanes westbound on 10th Avenue South.

A **public meeting** will take place on **Thursday, April 6, 2023**, at the Norris Center located at 755 8th Avenue South Naples, FL from 4:30pm to 6:30pm. The meeting will be in an open-house format, so please drop in at any time during this period to view the plans and provide feedback. We are looking forward to sharing more about this project with you.
